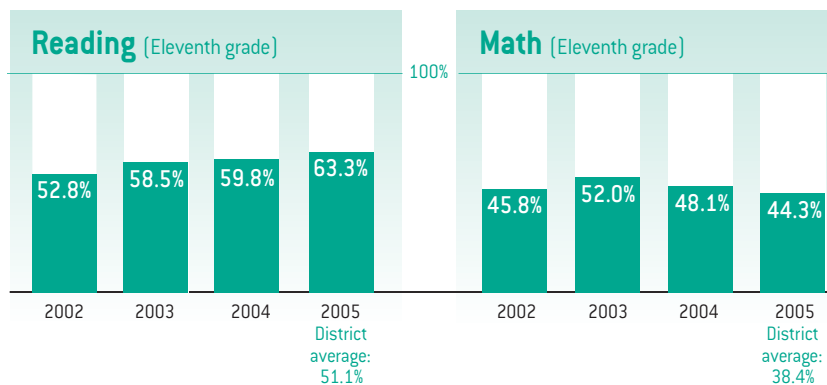

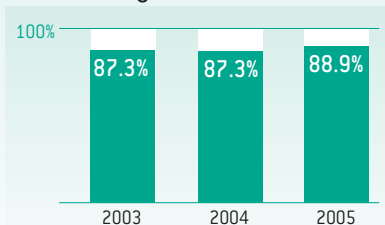

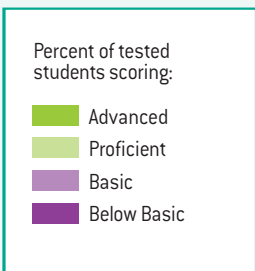

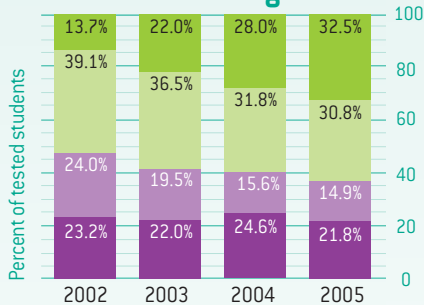

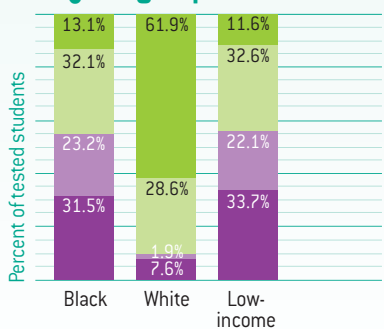
**Grade 11 Reading overall**
