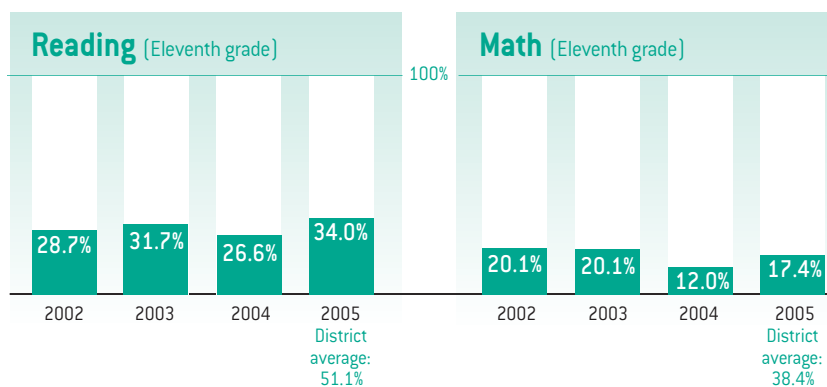

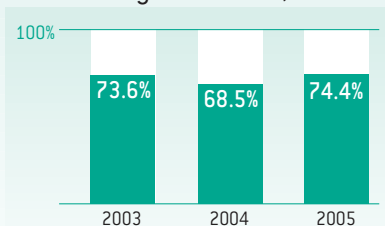

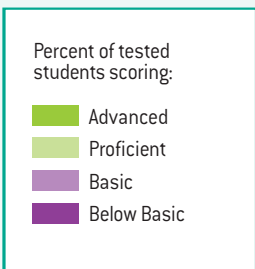

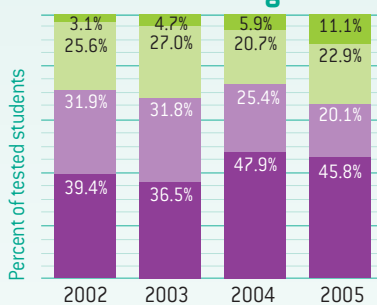

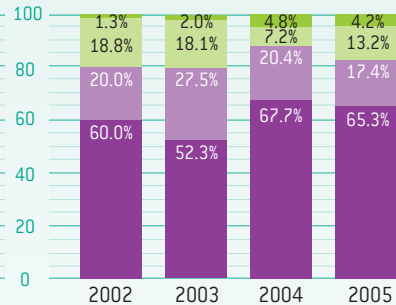

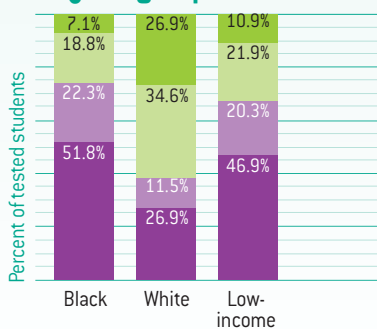
Grade 11 Reading overall
