In the 2010-11 school year:

The average 6-12 school had 611 students and 43 teachers.

92.2% of 6-12 students attended school on the average day.

94.1% of 6-12 teachers attended school on the average day.

57.6% of 6-12 students were eligible for free or reduced-price lunch (a measure of family poverty).

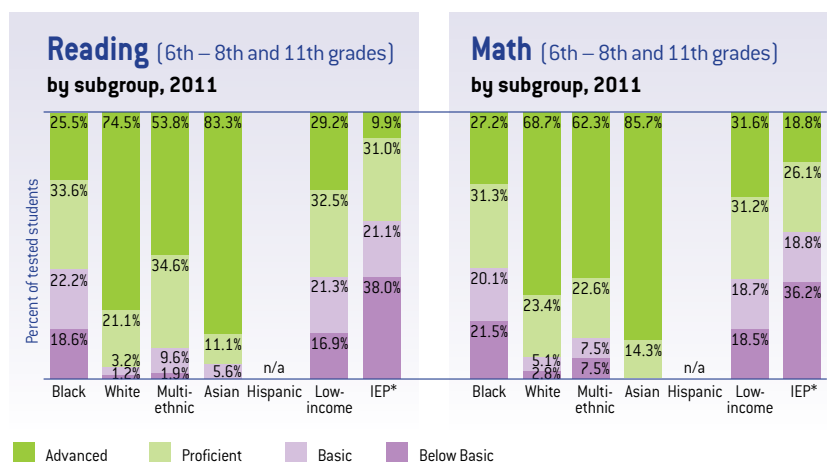

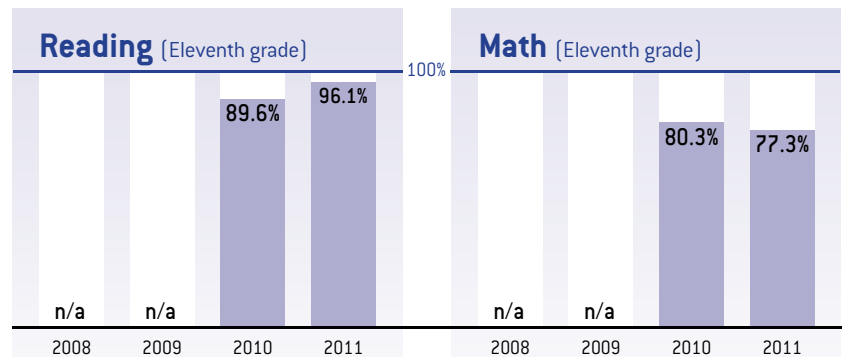

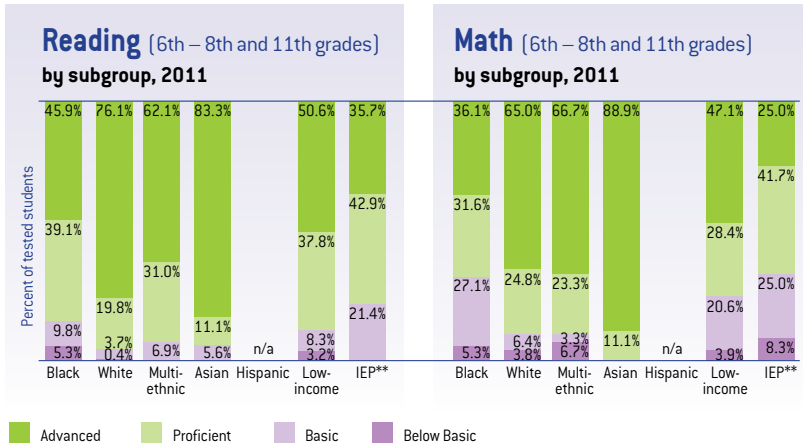

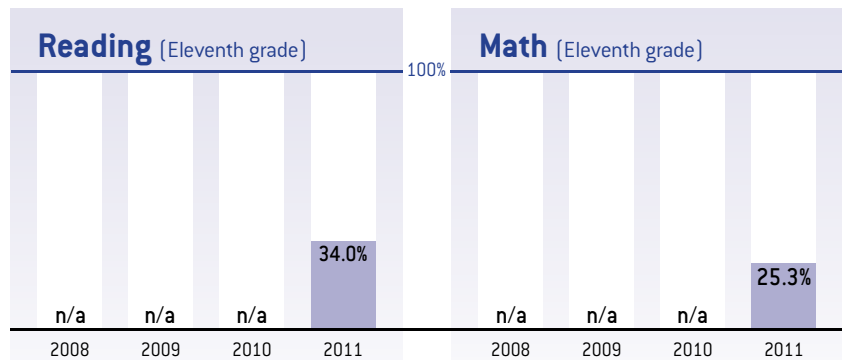

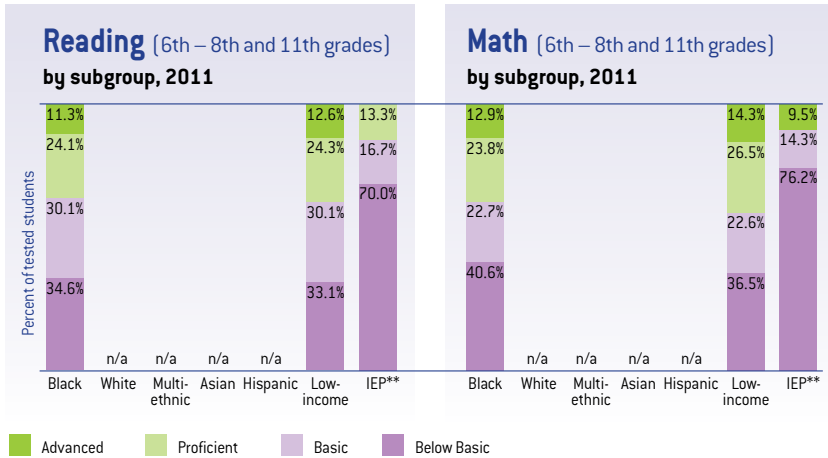

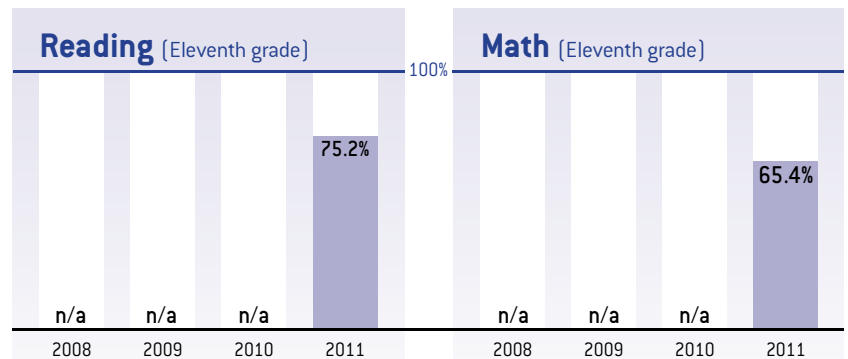

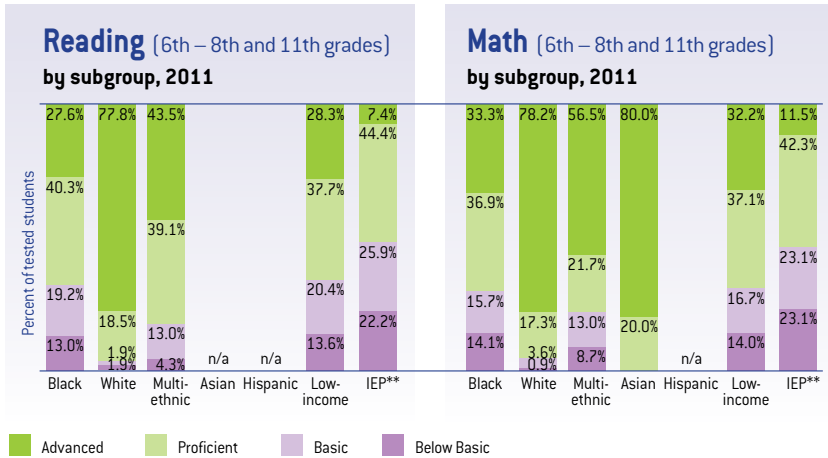

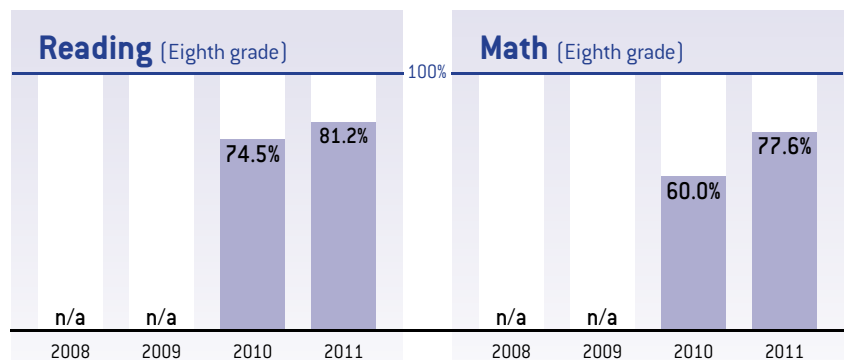

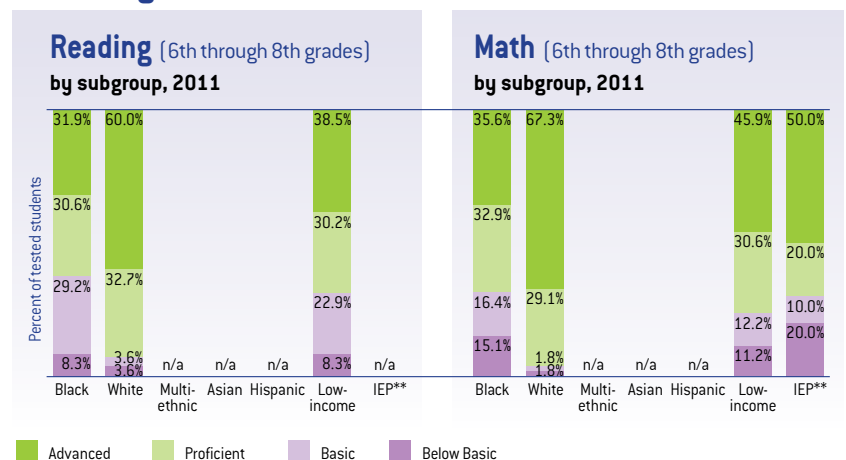
