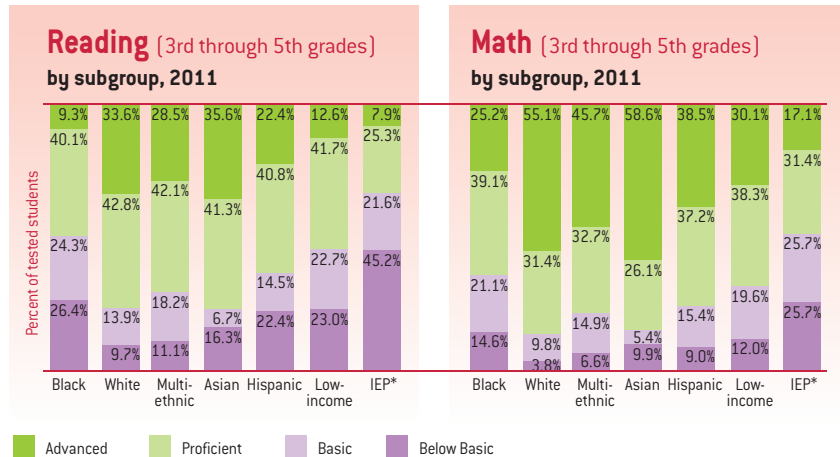

### Percentage of students at each PSSA achievement level (K-8 and elementary)



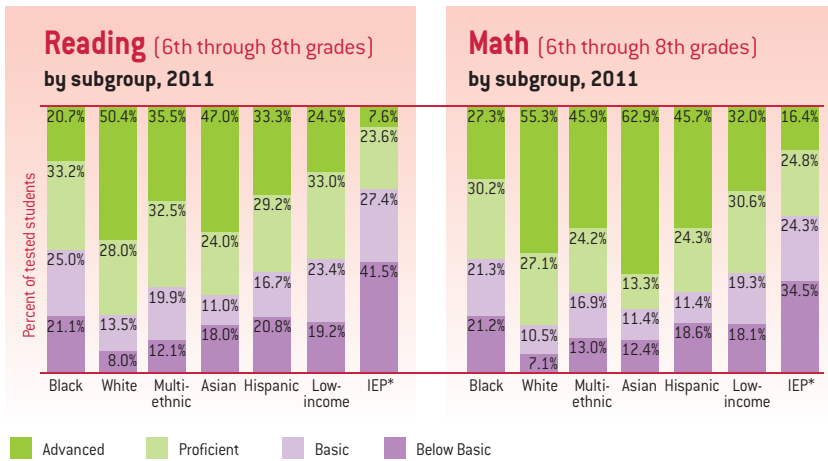

## Percentage of students at each PSSA achievement level



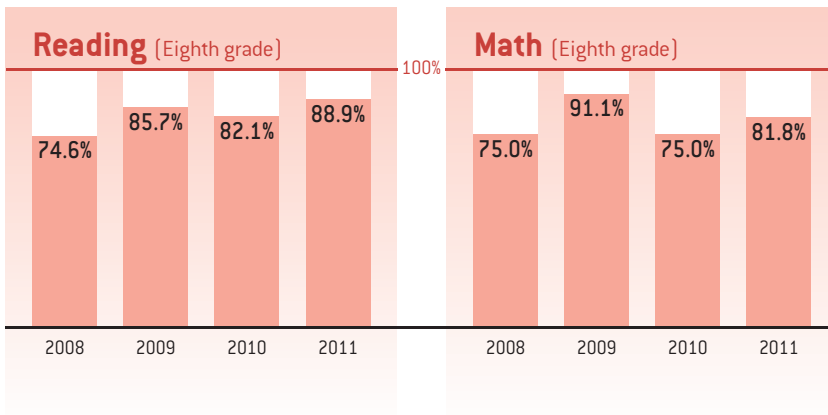

## Percentage of students at each PSSA achievement level



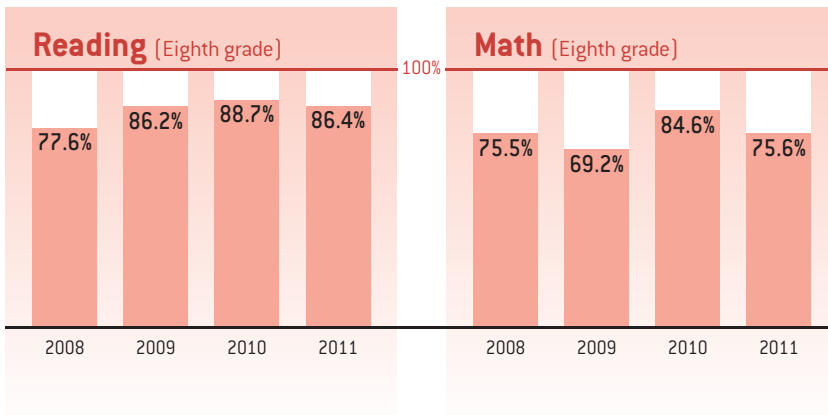

## Percentage of students at each PSSA achievement level



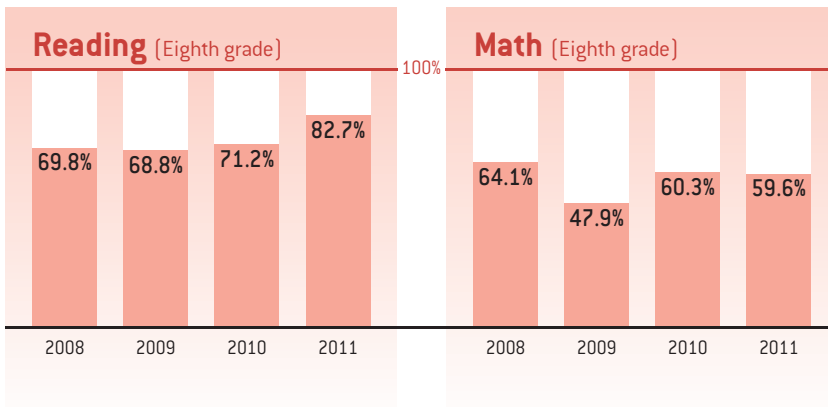

## Percentage of students at each PSSA achievement level



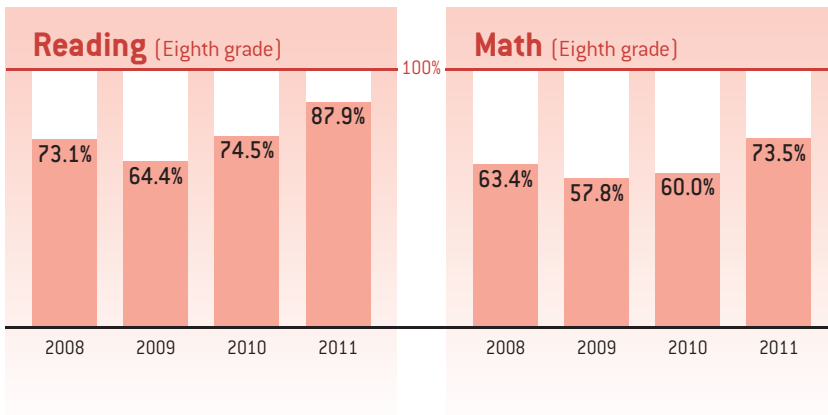

## Percentage of students at each PSSA achievement level



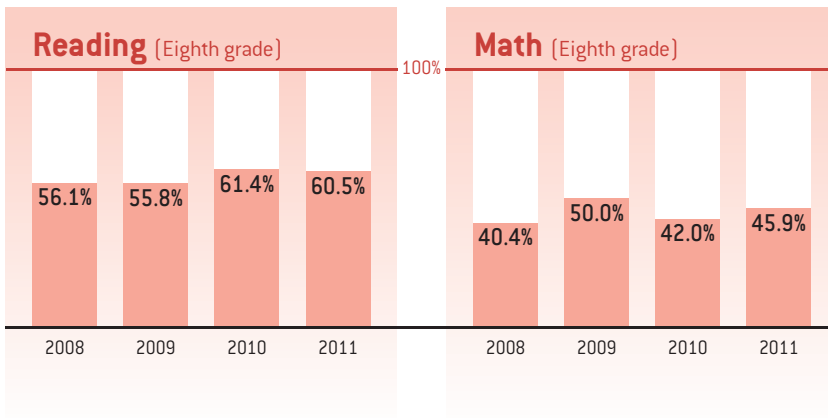

## Percentage of students at each PSSA achievement level



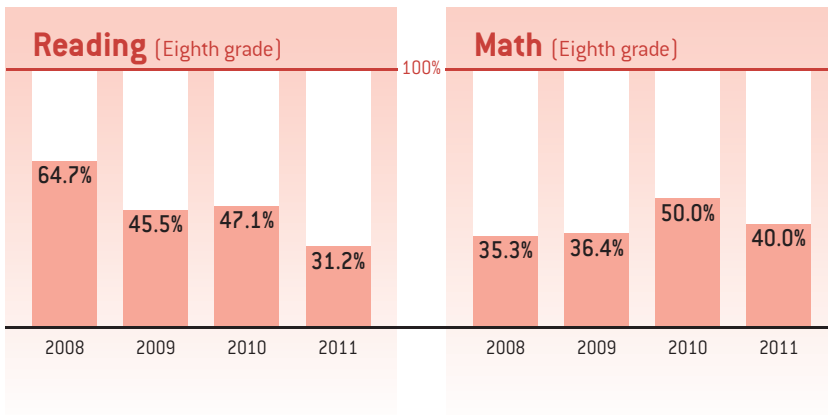

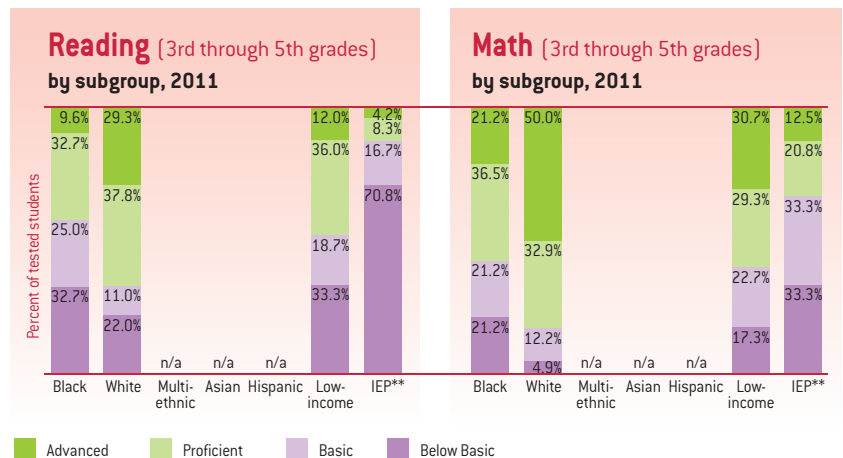

## Percentage of students at each PSSA achievement level



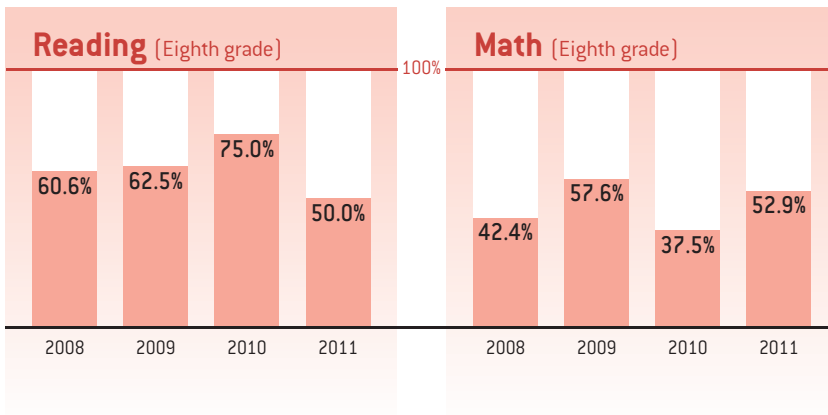
